The following information is an indication of the type of work that may be available to students at the time of their placement:

<b>Main Aims :</b>	Practical, community-based conservation and environmental activities. Ideal for those pursuing careers in conservation, tree surgery and outdoor working generally. This placement is also highly suitable and a great opportunity for those wishing to gain experience of working with a range of community groups for possible future careers such as adult social care, policing, social work, working with special needs people etc.		
<b>Key Tasks:</b>	Work regularly involves helping local people engage in practical, community-based conservation projects at a range of woodlands and nature reserves in the Chilterns and surrounding areas. The placement tasks include but are not limited to: Thinning trees, cutting scrub (inc controlled bonfires), step building, footpath & fencing repairs and litter picking etc. Only hand tools will be used and training will be given. Monitoring/surveying of trees/plants/butterflies and more may be undertaken, particularly during spring/summer placements. General work tasks as necessary – e.g. washing tools & kit after use, sweeping up the depot, preparing the volunteer tea kit, washing vans & general clearing up.		
<b>Requirements:</b>	STUDENTS SHOULD HAVE AN UP TO DATE TETANUS INJECTION		
<b>Clothing:</b>	Strong working/walking boots or wellies (no trainers). Casual and comfortable clothes suitable for outdoor work which may include helping with bonfires. Waterproof jackets & trousers will be required in wet weather. Hat recommended. PPE - Gloves, helmet, ear defenders and goggles are provided as required. All tools required will be provided.		
<b>Hours:</b>	Monday to Friday 9-5. Finish times may vary slightly.
